Stacey started in radio right after broadcasting college. She started as an afternoon host and quickly made her way to morning host. Stacey has hosted numerous high profile events including the 2003 Canada Winter Game Ceremonies. An award winning journalist, having her live broadcast win the RTNDA for "Spot News Coverage" and for the past three years she has won Gold for Best Radio Reporter in the Toronto Sun Reader's Choice Awards. ## JAKE GOLD



Jake Gold is one of Canada's most successful artist managers. He is co-owner of Kindling Music, an independent record label distributed by Warner Music Canada, and of The Management Trust, through which he is best known for his role in establishing and transforming The Tragically Hip into a national icon. Gold currently directs the careers of The Cliks, Sass Jordan, and Lily Frost. "A rock and roll road warrior, Jake is both all business and all

heart," said *Canadian Idol* Executive Producer John Brunton. Gold has been recognized by the annual Canadian Music Industry Awards as Manager of the Year in 1991, 1993 and 1994. He has been a member of the JUNO Awards Television and Talent committee since 2003. He is responsible for producing the War Child concert in Winnipeg, which drew crowds upwards of 100,000 people and raised over \$400,000 for War Child Canada.

## JOANNE WILDER



For nearly 12 years Q107 listeners have been spending their work day with Joanne Wilder. A graduate of Seneca College, Joanne landed her first gig in the radio hotbed known as Belleville, Ontario. From there, she moved from Toronto to Oshawa to St. Catharines, before finally winding up at the Mighty Q. She has dabbled in television and other projects but Q107 has been her home from 9am to 2pm since April 1998. Besides entertaining her listeners every weekday Joanne plays the hectic role of wife and mother and loves every minute of it.

## AL JOYNES
